

General Education Committee motions, April 2012

Motion #1: The General Education Committee moves that the WKU Colonnade Program implementation date will be **fall semester 2014**.

Motion #2: The General Education Committee moves that the World Language Proficiency standard in the WKU Colonnade Program be changed to read:

“Admitted students are expected to demonstrate language proficiency at the **‘novice high’** level before completing 60 hours of coursework. Additional courses may be taken to meet this proficiency.”

Motion #3: The General Education Committee moves that the WKU Colonnade Program’s “Connections” guidelines that relate to the level of “Connections” courses be changed to read:

“Although they may be counted **toward major or minor program degree requirements**, **Connections courses are classes at the 200-level or above** designed for the general student population, and should be taken after students have completed 21 hours of WKU Colonnade Program coursework or achieved junior status.”

Motion #4: The General Education Committee moves that the following language be added to the WKU Colonnade Program’s “Connections” guidelines, in order to better define what a “discipline” is:

“Courses selected must be from three different disciplines **(usually defined by course prefixes)**.”
