We have been asked by a faculty member to look into creating a policy regarding sectarian prayers at WKU sponsored events.

The suggested policy:

"Western Kentucky University, a public institution, is a multicultural community. Students, faculty, staff and employees are of many different religious persuasions and have the right to pray voluntarily in a non-disruptive fashion during the school day and read religious texts during their free time. Individual, voluntary religious activity by students, faculty, staff and employees is permitted; WKU-sponsored religious worship is not. Prayers given at University-sponsored public events may encompass moments of silence and should be nonsectarian. No WKU student, faculty, staff or employee attending a WKU-sponsored event as a representative of the University or any of its subdivisions may present a public sectarian prayer."
