The Kentucky General Assembly is currently in session, and there are a couple of House bills in process that impact postsecondary education.

<u>HB 14</u> and <u>HB 18</u> both propose broad, undefined restrictions on teaching race, sex, and religion in both K-12 and postsecondary classrooms.

The <u>AAUP</u> has flagged bills like this across the country, which they label educational gag orders, as potential violations of the core value of academic freedom.
