XII.B. Salary and Paychecks: Faculty members are typically employed on a nine-month basis and receive salary for that term of employment in twelve installments payable on the last business day of each month. The academic year runs from August 16 to May 15 with payments made July 1 to June 30. Paychecks are directly deposited per faculty authorization. New faculty members employed by August 15 receive their first paycheck at the end of August and receive 2/12 of their annual salary at that time. Salary and paycheck information may be obtained on the employee services page of TopNet.

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Revision/Addition:

XII.B. Salary and Paychecks: Faculty members typically are typically employed on a nine-month basis and receive salary for that term of employment in twelve installments payable on the last business day of each month. The academic year runs from August 16 to May 15 with payments made July 1 to June 30. The academic year begins on the Monday that is three (3) weeks before Labor Day and ends on the Friday after the spring grade submission deadline not to exceed two hundred eighty (280) continuous, calendar days with payments made July 1 to June 30. Paychecks are directly deposited per faculty authorization. New faculty members employed by August 15 receive their first paycheck at the end of August and receive 2/12 of their annual salary at that time. Salary and paycheck information may be obtained on the employee services page of TopNet.
