**University AI Committee:** Will Perry reports the committee is on a fact-finding mission. Created subcommittees: research, students, and pedagogy

**Institutional AI Platform:** The university is probably not financially able to adopt an enterprise institutional subscription for AI platform. The committee expressed concerns about whether this may make the university less competitive. The paid versions are much better and regarding students there is an equity question related to students who use a paid AI platform vs those who use the free versions.

**AI detectors:** Committee members have experience with AI detectors such as ChatGPT Zero, for student work, but found them not to be helpful.

### Pedagogy and AI

- Ethics and proper use of AI should be taught and reinforced.
- Critiquing AI outputs is a critical skill for students.
- How as faculty do we maintain critical thinking?
- Resources are needed by faculty/departments who will continue to assess students old-school such as proctoring, etc.
