Bill 10-22-F. A Bill to Amend the Student Government Association Constitution

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to Amend the Duties of President and Executive Vice President (EVP)

WHEREAS: Section 2.3 of the Constitution describes the duties of the Student Body President, and

WHEREAS: Section 2.3.9 reads:

“Submit appointees to University committees where student representation is requested by the University with approval by a majority vote at the next Senate meeting.”, and

WHEREAS: The Executive Vice President has made these appointments for these last two Student Government terms, and

WHEREAS: Section 2.4 of the Constitution describes the duties of the Executive Vice President, and

WHEREAS: There is no subsection of 2.4 which reflects making University committee appointments as a duty of the Executive Vice President, and

WHEREAS: Section 2.3.9 will be removed from the Constitution, and

WHEREAS: A new section numbered 2.4.11 will be added moving this duty under the role of EVP, reading:

“Submit appointees to University committees where student representation is requested by the University with approval by a majority vote at the next Senate meeting.”

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University will amend its Constitution.
