Bill 5-22-F. A Bill to Amend the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University.

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to Amend its Constitution to add additional duties for college representative senators.

WHEREAS: Section 3.6.8. of the constitution states:

“One (1) senator from each academic college elected by students within the respective college for a total of five (5) senators”

WHEREAS: Senators who represent academic colleges have no separate duties from other senators positions,

WHEREAS: the additional requirement of an annual meeting with the dean or associate dean from the college which they represent would ensure that the senator remains in touch with their college and is able to write more informed legislation specific to their college’s needs,

WHEREAS: A new Section will be created that will be 3.7 titled “Duties of Academic College Senators:” and it will state:

“Senators who represent an academic college must meet with the dean or associate dean of their respective college at least once per term of office.”

WHEREAS: All numbered sections under 3.7 will be updated accordingly.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University will amend its Constitution.
