**Resolution 7-25-F. Resolution to Support the Installation of Additional Handicapped-Accessible Restrooms and/or Stalls in Grise Hall**

- PURPOSE:** For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to support the installation of additional handicapped-accessible restrooms and stalls in Grise Hall.
- WHEREAS:** Grise Hall sees thousands of students daily and currently lacks sufficient handicapped-accessible restroom facilities to serve its population, and
- WHEREAS:** Students with disabilities cannot easily access basic restroom facilities with adequate accommodations in Grise Hall, creating immediate barriers to learning and campus participation for those students, and
- WHEREAS:** The ADA mandates sufficient accessible facilities. Current capacity in Grise Hall fails to meet this requirement, and
- WHEREAS:** Students have made it clear to several Senators that Grise Hall is in need of more accessible restrooms, and
- WHEREAS:** Adding additional handicapped-accessible facilities is a direct solution that removes barriers for students with disabilities and helps create a campus that is suitable for all Hilltoppers, and
- THEREFORE:** Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University will support the installation of additional handicapped-accessible restrooms and stalls in Grise Hall.
