Bill 26-17-S A Bill to Amend the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to amend the Constitution to limit legislative powers of the Executive Branch of the Western Kentucky University Student Government Association.

WHEREAS: Section 2.10.1.2 of the constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to strike the phrase “Make Proposals on matters of policy and,” and

WHEREAS: Leaving Section 2.10.1.2 to state, “Recommend plans of action for consideration by the Senate.” Ceasing the power to propose legislation of the Executive Branch of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University, and

WHEREAS: Currently, the Constitution allows for Executive Branch members to propose legislation to the senate floor, and

WHEREAS: This is not in tradition of the United States Government, in which the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University is modeled after.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University amend the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to limit legislative power held by the Executive Branch of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University.
