Bill 5-17-S Funding for the Power UP Political Forum

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to allocate \$200.00 to the Intercultural Student Engagement Center to support the Power UP Political Forum.

WHEREAS: This event will be a non-partisan student forum hosted by the Intercultural Student Engagement Center (ISEC) during Black History Month to educate members of the WKU community on pressing political topics and citizens' constitutional rights, and
