Bill 19-16-F Funding for Extended Library Hours

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of WKU to allocate \$1,200.00 from Legislative Discretionary funding to cover the cost of extended operating hours for Helm-Cravens Library during finals week in the Fall 2016 and Spring 2017 semesters.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University allocate \$1,200.00 from Legislative Discretionary funding to the Helm-Cravens Library account to cover the additional cost of the library remaining open until 2am during finals week for the Fall 2016 and Spring 2017 semesters.
