Bill 41-22-S Funding for an Earth Day Tie-Dye Tabling Event.

WHEREAS: \$125 will come from the Legislative Discretionary Funds, and

WHEREAS: The event will take place at Centennial Mall on Friday, April 22nd from 10 AM to 2 PM in Centennial Mall, and

WHEREAS: The theme for this year's Earth Day is sustainable fashion, so recycled fashion from tie dye is a fitting activity for the Campus Improvements and Sustainability Committee, and

WHEREAS: Due to COVID-19, WKU has gone 2 years without a proper Earth Day celebration, and

WHEREAS: Earth Day is our hallmark holiday for sustainability and environmental awareness, and

WHEREAS: SGA has a strong history dating back to 2007 of planning the Earth Day celebration alongside the Office of Sustainability, and

WHEREAS: Campus Improvements and Sustainability Committee has discussed its contribution to the 2022 Earth Day Festival with the Office of Sustainability since the start of the spring semester and intends on delivering on its promise, and

WHEREAS: SGA will promote the work of the WKU Office of Sustainability and encourage students to support the environmental protection principles upheld by Earth Day, and

WHEREAS: In addition to promoting this event, Campus Improvements and Sustainability Committee will be tabling this Earth Day event with a tie-dye activity for students, and

WHEREAS: \$60 will be used to purchase 3 Tulip One-Step Tie-Dye Party, 18 Pre-Filled Bottles, Creative Group Activity, All-in-1 Fashion Design Kit, 1 Pack, Rainbow, and

WHEREAS: \$5 will purchase Amazon Rubber Bands, and

WHEREAS: \$105 will acquire 3 packages of 10 Large Unisex White Cotton T-shirts with one 2 large package
