Bill 4-22-S. A bill to amend the Western Kentucky University Student Government Association Constitution.

WHEREAS: Requiring the mandatory presence of authors places an undue burden on scheduling and deters students from writing legislation, and

WHEREAS: Communication is can be done efficiently in ways other than in person, and

WHEREAS: Section 3.8.2.3 will now be read as
“Ensure that all proposed legislation has been properly researched by the author(s) and encourage the presence of at least one author at the Legislative Operations Committee meetings.”
