

SGA Senate Meeting Minutes

- The fifth meeting of the fifteenth Senate was called to order by Nathan Cherry at 5:01 on September 27th, 2016.
- The minutes from the last Senate meeting were approved by unanimous consent.
- **Guest Speaker- Melanie Evans, Coordinator for Sexual Assault Services and Student Conduct:** The Office of Student Conduct focuses on ensuring that students and students' guests practice civility. The Office of Student Conduct works to enforce Title IX and address issues such as, hazing, sexual misconduct, harassment, stalking, dating violence, domestic violence, and sexual exploitation.
