SGA Senate Meeting Minutes

- The second meeting of the sixteenth Senate was called to order by Ryan Richardson at 5:00 pm on September 5th, 2017.
- The minutes from the last Senate meeting were approved by unanimous consent.
- Executive Vice President Savannah Molyneaux: There will be a trip to Frankfort for all senators in the Spring, around the first week of classes, on Wednesday or Thursday. We will be having individual meetings with the legislatures while in Frankfort. The trip will count as an excused absence from classes. If you have any further suggestions for the trip, let Savannah know. There are still several spots open on the University Committees.
- President Andi Dahmer: Senate elections will take place on the 11th and 12th (next Monday and Tuesday). There is now a formal application for senator appointments on the SGA website, in response to senator Hurst's bill proposal last week. President Dahmer encourages everyone to read the constitution and bylaws and clarifies some points she had received questions on. She discusses the differences between censor, censure, and judicial review. She also touches on the procedure involved in the impeachment process. The term quorum is also explained.
