RECOSURIES HIGH SCHOOL JOURNALISM WORKSHOP



JOURNALISM IS MORE ESSENTIAL TODAY THAN EVER BEFORE.

Thanks to the WKU Sisterhood, XPOSURE in 2019 brought together a diverse group of students to study journalism in a real-world setting at WKU.

We assembled a class of 12, ensuring that FEMALES and MINORITIES – groups that are underrepresented in the nation's newsrooms – were well represented in XPOSURE.



We were able to do this at NO COST to the students, eliminating any economic barriers that could prevent their participation.



We spent \$13,481 staging XPOSURE, or about \$1,123 per student - including food, lodging, vehicles, programming, supplies, printing and small stipends for coaches.

The \$5,000 grant from the WKU Sisterhood paid stipends, printing costs and some small miscellaneous expenses.



Some coaches returned their stipends to the XPOSURE Fund.
