

Ken and Melissa Dennison SKyTeach Scholarship

Guidelines for the Ken and Melissa Dennison SKyTeach Scholarship

1. Recipients of the Ken and Melissa Dennison SKyTeach Scholarships are to be full-time students at Western Kentucky University and enrolled in the SKyTeach program.
3. First preference must be given to scholarships for participants of the SKyTeach Program who are graduates of Glasgow High School.
4. Recipients must have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 or a minimum college cumulative GPA of 2.75.
5. Prior to receiving the scholarship, selected recipients must sign a Code of Conduct policy encompassing how they represent WKU and the SKyTeach Program.
6. If no student meets the above criteria, available funds may be used for the following areas of the SKyTeach Program:
 - a. Scholarships for participants of the SKyTeach Program who are graduates of Barren County or Grayson County schools.
 - b. Internships in Glasgow and Barren County and/or Grayson County.
 - b. Programming in middle and high school Math and Science classrooms in the Glasgow, Barren County, and/or Grayson County School District, conducted by SKyTeach participants. This programming will be continually reviewed and developed by the WKU SKyTeach representatives and representatives of the above named school districts.
