In-text citations: (Author, year, p.#)

Reference List, Books:

Last, F. M. (year). *Title of work: Capital letter after colon*. Location: Publisher.

Reference List, Article from an online journal:

Last, F. M. (year). Title of article. *Title of Online Periodical*, volume # (issue #), page range.

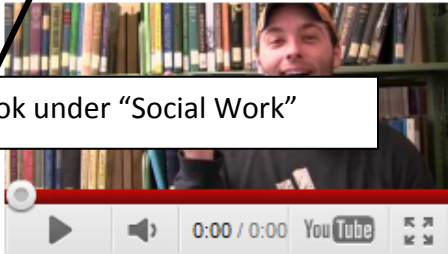
