

WKU CREDIT FOR LEARNING COURSES

- CFL Academy Course I, **SWRK 571: Introduction to KY Child Welfare** is a (7) week course. The course includes three (3) weeks in-class, face-to-face time and four (4) weeks online on Eastern Kentucky University's (EKU's) Blackboard system. The in-class courses are as follows:
Foundations: Core Principles
Foundations: Acceptance Criteria & Medical Indicators of Child Maltreatment
Foundations: Assessing Safety and Risk
- CFL Academy Course II, **SWRK 579: Partnership, Support and Advocacy of Children and Adults (in Need)** is a 4-week course. The course includes two (2) weeks face-to-face class time and two (2) weeks online the EKU Blackboard system. The in-class courses are as follows:
Partnership: Assessment, Documentation and Court
Partnership: Collaborative Practice
- CFL Academy Course III, **SWRK 574: Enhancing Safety and Permanency of Children**, is a five (5) week course. The course includes three (3) face-to-face weeks, one (1) week online Blackboard (Bb), followed by two in class days, followed by one week online Blackboard, followed by three days in class. The in-class courses are as follows:
Case Management: In Home Case Planning and Services
Case Management: Out of Home Care
Case Management: Permanency Options
- CFL Academy Course IV, **SWRK 573: Assessment and Case Management of Child Sexual Abuse**, is a three (3) week course. The course includes one week of online pre-work, five (5) days face-to-face, and two (2) weeks of online learning on EKU Blackboard.
- CFL Advanced P&P Supervisor Seminar Series has 6-parts designed for Supervisors;
This Course meets two days each month over a 6-month period.
 - **SWRK 576: Advanced Casework Practice in Child Welfare**
 - **SWRK 577: Supervision of Advanced Casework in Child Welfare**
 - **SWRK 578: Coaching and Mentoring Child Welfare Practice**
 - This series is supplemented with Bb online learning.
