### Dear Parent/Guardian:

The following pages contain the application and information forms necessary for your child to begin the application process for the Upward Bound program. We, the staff of Upward Bound, request that you and your child read the information provided to become familiar with the program. Joining Upward Bound is an educational commitment which hopefully will last until your child's high school graduation. It is important to understand what services are provided and what is expected of an Upward Bound student.

Upward Bound is a federally funded educational program designed to help high school students in academic areas so they can further their education after high school graduation. If your child is accepted into the Upward Bound program, there are several activities in which he/she will be involved. During the school year, there will be once-amonth Saturday meetings on Western's campus. These meetings will involve academic programs and social functions. We also provide twice-a-month counselor visits to the high school to meet with our students. All Upward Bound students are required to attend a six-week summer session on Western's campus in which classes are taught, recreational activities are offered, and field trips are taken.

In order to begin the application process, you and your child must complete the application packet and mail it back to the Upward Bound office. Please be careful to complete and sign each form/page as needed. Once the application packet has been mailed back to the Upward Bound office, the counselor for your child's school will interview your child at school and contact you to set up an appointment to visit with you. Completing the application does not guarantee acceptance into the Upward Bound program.

Some of the information that we gather, i.e. income information, is required in order to ensure that only those who are eligible actually participate in Upward Bound. The information is protected by the Privacy Act. No one may see the information unless they work with or for the Upward Bound program or are specifically authorized to see the information.

## WHAT ARE SOME ACTIVITIES AND SERVICES OF U.B.?

- \* During the school year--
  - 1) Counselor visits twice per month at your high school
  - 2) Enrichment sessions one Saturday a month on Western's campus
- \* During the summer--
  - 1) Attend a six week residential program at Western
  - 2) Live in a residence hall during the six weeks--home on weekends
  - 3) Attend academic classes in English, science, reading, math, and foreign language
  - 4) Participate in elective classes such as computers, swimming, arts and crafts, and team sports
  - 5) Take trips to area attractions and visit a metropolitan area
  - 6) Opportunity to network with students from other counties
- \* Extra attractions--
  - 1) All expenses are paid for by Upward Bound
  - 2) Seniors are awarded a stipend for participation
  - 3) Upward Bound will provide a waiver for the ACT

#### **HOW DO I APPLY FOR U.B.?**

- \* You and your parents must have an interview with an Upward Bound counselor and complete the application forms
- \* You will be notified of your acceptance status after the interview and review of your school grades

Because Upward Bound is federally funded, our students must be considered either low income (according to annual federal low income levels) or a potential first generation college student (parent(s) that the student lives with cannot have a four-year college degree.) The majority of our students must be both.
