VETERANS UPWARD BOUND SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Our goal at VUB is to help veterans improve their lives through higher education. One way we do that is by providing community-funded scholarship opportunities to help veterans attend the postsecondary schools of their choice.

The 2021 deadline for returning the application is Friday, June 25, 2021, with scholarship recipients being announced before the fall semester (date TBD).

To be eligible, the applicant must:

- Be a current or past VUB participant who plans to enroll in school by the fall semester.
- Complete the attached VUB scholarship application.
- Submit an essay entitled, "How Veterans Upward Bound Has Benefited Me in My Pursuit of Higher Education." This essay should also address your financial need for this scholarship. It should be no more than two typed, double-spaced pages.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

The VUB computer lab is available for those without computer access, and instructors can offer guidance and/or proofreading for the essay. Due to limited staffing in the office, please call 270-745-5310 for more information and computer lab availability.
